STANDARDS:

- A. If illegal acts are committed while participating in LCCMH services, appropriate action will be taken.
- B. Employees are entitled to file and pursue charges against persons served committing illegal acts against them.

PROCEDURES:

- A. Staff are encouraged to discuss clinical implication with their Supervisor or administrative staff before filing a criminal complaint.
- B. Supervisors or other administrative staff will not discourage, reprimand or otherwise interfere with an employee's right to pursue such action.
