

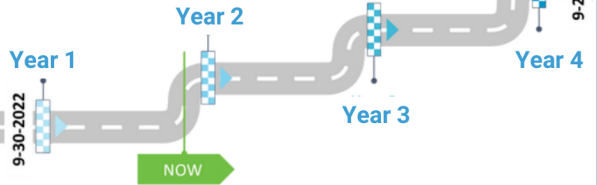
CCBHC Grant Update

In September 2022, Lapeer County Community Mental Health (LCCMH) was awarded a four-year Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) Planning, Development, and Implementation Grant through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA). The purpose of a CCBHC is to ensure access to coordinated, comprehensive behavioral health care by prioritizing evidence-based services, quick access to treatment, and care coordination of behavioral health care, physical health care, social services, and other community resources.

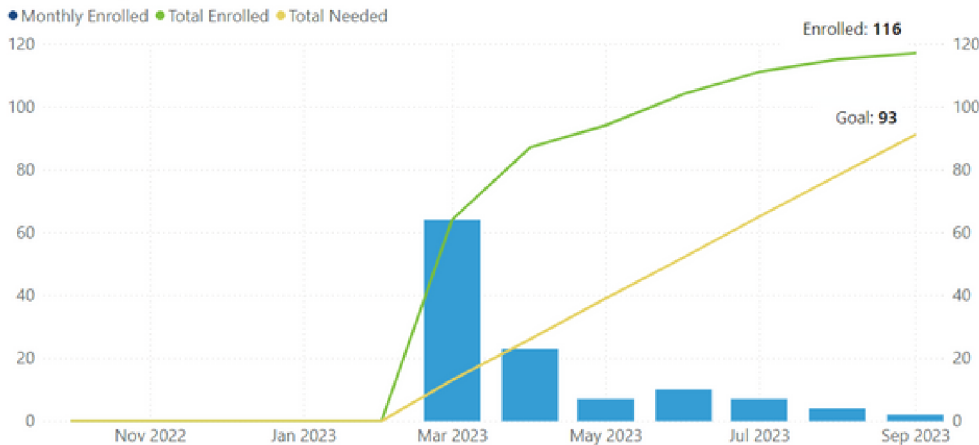
Grant Enrollment & NOMs Assessments

LCCMH surpassed their Year 1 enrollment goal.

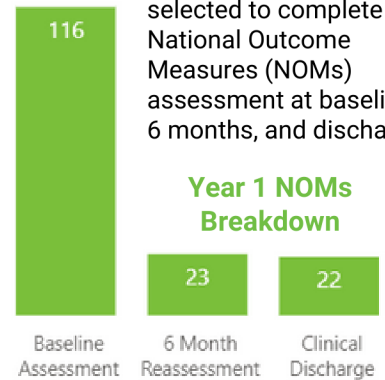
Grant Cycle



Enrollment by Month



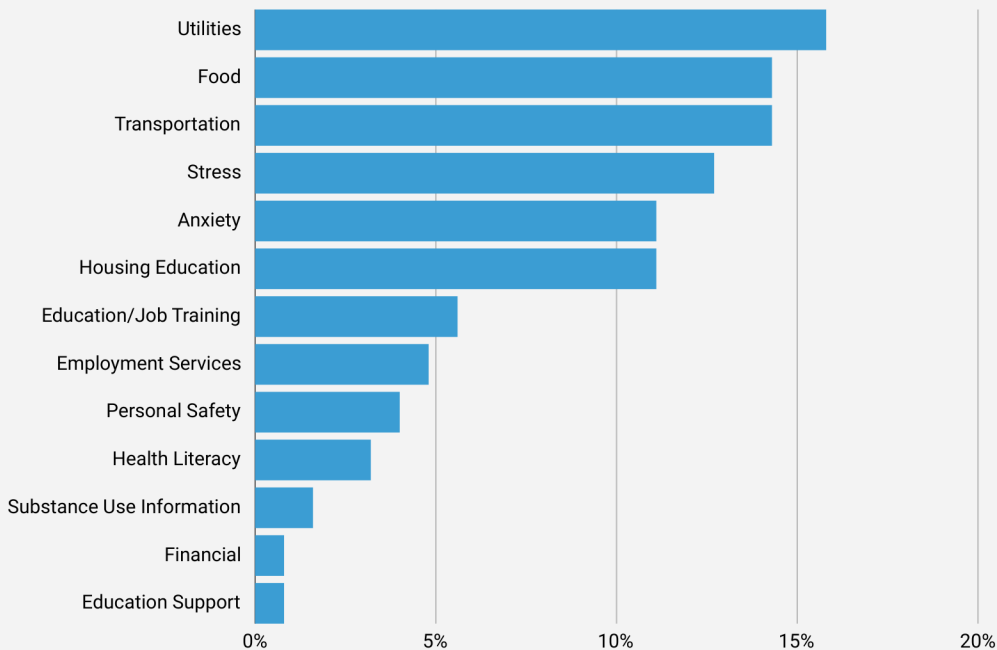
Individuals receiving services are randomly selected to complete a National Outcome Measures (NOMs) assessment at baseline, 6 months, and discharge.



PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT

Community Health Access Program (CHAP)

Percent Breakdown of Referrals



CHAP is a healthcare initiative program that aims to improve support with social drivers of health (SDoH) for residents in the Mid-Michigan region. LCCMH began collaborating with CHAP earlier this year and officially launched their partnership in late August. LCCMH referred 24 individuals in the first 6 weeks, with 75% actively supported and 14% successfully connected to resources. The program has made a significant impact, addressing various individual needs as shown in the chart on the left.

Outcomes and Performance

As part of the CCBHC grant, LCCMH is tracking performance on several SAMHSA-required measures, including:

- Infrastructure, Development, Prevention, and Mental Health Promotion (IPP) indicators
- Clinical Quality Measures (CQMs)
- CCBHC-developed Goals and Objectives

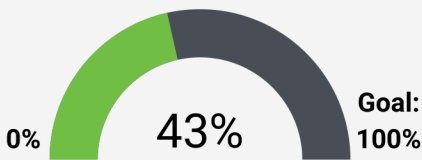
This quarter, we are highlighting performance for three of LCCMH's CCBHC-developed objectives that focus on **staff training opportunities and increased screening for health risk behaviors**:

GOAL 1

Increase provision of evidence-based practices

Train Children's Master Level Clinicians in Trauma-Focused CBT (TF-CBT)

GOAL 2

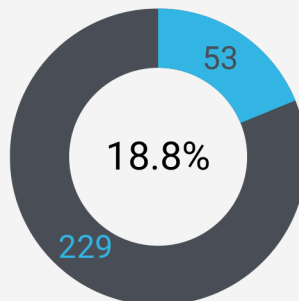
Increase screening of specific health risk behaviors and documentation of a follow-up plan in the EHR

Increase Screening for Alcohol Use in the Co-Occurring Department.
