POLICY:

Lapeer County Community Mental Health (LCCMH) provides mental health and wellness training, education and other community benefit activities for community partners and the Lapeer Community.

STANDARDS:

- A. LCCMH provides community benefit activities as required in the contract with MDHHS and the Region 10 Prepaid Inpatient Health Plan (PIHP) Delegation Agreement.
- B. LCCMH Quality Improvement Staff track community benefit activities and provide a quarterly activity report to the LCCMH Board and the PIHP.
- C. Staff offer resources to access mental health services when a mental health need is identified.
- D. LCCMH will maintain staff and resources to meet the mental health training and education needs of the community.
- E. LCCMH in-person trainings available to the community are listed on the agency webpage with online and phone registration options.

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- F. Training registrations will not exceed the maximum occupancy of the training venue.
- G. Trainings may be conducted at LCCMH or at the site of the group requesting the training, provided the accommodations meet the needs of the curriculum.
- H. LCCMH staff will follow fidelity measures for Evidence Based Program Trainings.
- I. Trainings will be provided at no cost as funding permits. The Chief Executive Officer (CEO) will set the rates for training when a fee is necessary, not to exceed the cost of the individual training materials.
- J. Trainings are offered during regular business hours 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.
- K. Trainings and community benefit activities may be offered in the evenings and on weekends with prior approval from the CEO or Chief Operating Officer (COO).
- L. For any staff proposing to offer Continuing Education Units (CEU's) for a training, the CEO must approve the request before the application for CEU's is submitted to the accrediting body.
 - 1. CEU's require an application to the accrediting body.
 - 2. LCCMH will pay the CEU application fee when approved by the CEO.
 - 3. All trainings approved by the accrediting body for continuing education units must follow the guidelines to ensure compliance with the standards for attendees to receive the CEU. It is the trainer's responsibility to ensure compliance.

DEFINITIONS:

Community Benefit Activities: Any activities designed to promote wellness and healthy communities. Community based activities may include: outreach activities, partnership arrangements, cross training with community service personnel, participation in community bodies, and systems of care initiatives.
