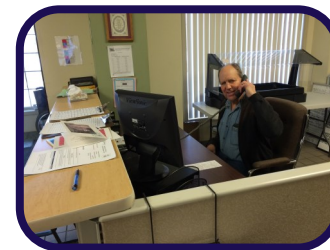

What is *harmonyhall* Clubhouse?

Harmony Hall Clubhouse is a membership of people working side-by-side to achieve their goals. It is offered to persons in the community recovering from a mental illness. The Clubhouse provides its members many opportunities to regain work, further their education, and focus on wellness. They participate in a work – ordered, structured day, which is the core component. Members develop interpersonal relationships, independent living skills, job skills, and ultimately build their self-esteem and confidence.

Cost of Services

Services provided are based on medical necessity. Lapeer CMH serves people who have Medicaid, Healthy Michigan, MI Child and people who have no insurance. If you have no insurance, we will help you apply for Medicaid or insurance through the Health Insurance Marketplace. We do not deny anyone services based on their ability to pay, when they meet medical necessity.



Dining Service Unit

Members working in the Dining Service Unit are responsible for meal preparations in the Clubhouse ServSafe® certified commercial kitchen, serving lunches and providing a wonderful dining experience for Clubhouse members and guests.

Member Service Unit

The Member Service Unit is responsible for Clubhouse billing, maintaining finances, publishing the Club's newsletter, reception, outreach efforts, and office maintenance. Members participating in the Member Service Unit are also responsible for operating the Clubhouse Employment Office.
